International Workshop " 1989 Democratic revolutions in the center and Eastern Europe and the fall of the Berlin Wall" held in Potsdam (Germany), December 3-5, 2018

As part of the European Decades Project, the Europe for Citizens Program, led by the Altius Foundation, an international workshop will take place from December 3 to 5, with various study activities, presentations and exchanges of experiences with young Europeans from Germany, Poland, Greece, Bulgaria, Spain and Serbia attending to a specific moment in the history of European construction: democratic revolutions in the center and Eastern Europe and the fall of the Berlin Wall. During the events held each partner country of the project will present the influence of these events in their country.

The objective of the project is to make citizens and especially young people aware of the process of European construction as well as the main achievements: peace, reconciliation between countries in conflict, democracy, etc. as well as strengthening European citizenship and the collaboration of social entities at European level.
