Coming by Train (cercanía) from the airport:

At the airport's T4 terminal, take the Cercanías train to Chamartín (12 minutes). Once there, take the C3 or C4 Cercanía train lines to Sol (2 stops, 8 minutes), from where you can walk to the hotel. Take Calle Carretas to Plaza de Jacinto Benavente. Turn left to enter Plaza del Ángel and arrive at Hostal Persal (5 minutes).

Coming by Taxi from the airport:

Estimated duration: 30 mins.

From any terminal, the tariff is fixed to 30€ including luggage.
